

Con Edison & GelTech Wrap 'Firelce' Testing

GelTech Solutions, Inc. (OTCQB: GLTC) creators of Firelce, a water-enhancing fire suppressant, successfully completed field tests with Con Edison (NYSE: ED).

"Con Edison's field testing under live conditions demonstrated that Firelce's fire suppression qualities reduces risks to utility workers and equipment, as well as New Yorkers," said Michael Cordani, GelTech chief executive officer. "The performance of our product reinforces the results achieved during Con Edison's earlier testing under controlled, laboratory conditions."

Firelce is an additive to fire suppression systems. It also has been used by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to fight wildfires.

GelTech Solutions' work with Con Edison is the first with an electric utility. Con Edison engineers and technicians found Firelce puts out underground fires more quickly than other systems.

Along with the successful field results, the Florida based GelTech also announced the opening of a regional support facility in Brooklyn, New York.

"The opening of this new facility is further evidence of our continued commitment and dedication to support the demands of our client base," said Cordani. "We look forward to the strengthening of our relationship with Con Edison as we both pursue our common goal: Safety."
