Feds to Sell Coal Lease Near Buckskin Mine

GILLETTE, Wyo. (AP) — The Bureau of Land Management has agreed to make a 1,200-acre tract next to Kiewit Mining Group Inc.'s Buckskin Mine available for a coal lease.

The bureau says the 1,253-acre tract has 167 million tons of mineable coal. The [Gillette News Record](#) [1] reports Kiewit had applied for the lease in 2006, so it could extend the life of the mine by about 10 years.

The BLM said Wednesday that a date for the coal lease sale hadn't been set yet.
